Monklands Sailing Club would like to invite all Flying Fifteens to our opening regatta to be held over the weekend of 10th – 11th of April. We hope the weekend will be friendly if competitive and be the best possible start to the coming season.

The weekend will also be the first in the new and eagerly awaited "Sottich Flying Fifteen Travellers Series". The Scottish Travellers Series with Saturn Sails and Henri Lloyd as principal sponsors provides everything from standard 4 race weekends to passage racing in the spectacular scenery of the west coast of Scotland. Five events are to be held with four of them counting towards overall results along with prizes of "Furthest travelled" and "Most improved" being amongst others awarded. With more sponsorship being announced, this will be a fantastic series to get onboard with over the coming season.

In an effort to encourage participation, we, at Monklands, intend to relax the requirement for competitors to produce valid race certificates, however, this doesn't mean you can turn up in a 49'er with a 15's logo on the sail but if you have an older boat whose certificate has been lost for example or if you have never tried travelling and are unsure of your boats official status, then don't worry... we'd love to see you. The regatta will be run according to the current Racing Rules of Sailing 2009, BIFFA and those of Monklands Sailing Club as laid out in the sailing instructions.

The overall prize for the weekend will be the "Monklands 50th Anniversary Cup" which the winner will hold for the year. There will be other prizes awarded for the weekend that will be announced later.

Food and light refreshments will be available through out the weekend and is included in the entry fee.

The entry fee for the event will be £25 per boat which can be paid on the day. (Please intimate by Sat. 3rd April your intention to participate to allow for catering needs)
