EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN

- 1. WITHOUT ENDANGERING YOURSELF, GIVE ANY ASSISTANCE YOU CAN.**
- 2. ENSURE THE SAFETY OF OTHERS. BE PRUDENT, BUT DON'T HESITATE TO;**
- 3. CALL THE EMERGENCY SERVICES AS PER ABOVE INFO.**
- 4. DESCRIBE THE INCIDENT AND GIVE THE LOCATION OF THE CLUB.**
- 5. IF SOMEONE AVAILABLE SEND THEM TO SHORE ROAD TO DIRECT THE EMERGENCY SERVICES.**
- 6. REPORT A MAJOR INCIDENT TO A COMMITTEE MEMBER**
- 7. RECORD THE INCIDENT. THE ACCIDENT BOOK IS IN THE RACE BOX.**
- 8. FOR A MAJOR INCIDENT, NOTE ACTION TAKEN, TIMES ETC, AND ENCOURAGE ANYONE ELSE INVOLVED TO DO SO INDEPENDENTLY.**
- 9. DO NOT TALK TO THE PRESS. COMMITTEE MEMBERS OR RYA WILL DO THIS.**

The RYA document on dealing with major incidents is in the Clubhouse, and similar instructions on same are in the emergency packs carried aboard the patrol Ribs.
